Sunday April 18th - 6AM to 2PM*

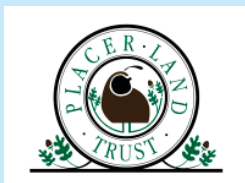
Join us for this exclusive opportunity to experience Bruin Ranch's 2,300 acres of
